Researchers from MZU discover new Trimeresurus snake species in Mizoram

Aizawl: Prof. H.T. Lalremsanga, a professor from the Zoology department of Mizoram University (MZU), and his research scholars have discovered a new species of Trimeresurus snake in Mizoram to be the first of such species in the country. The new species is called Trimeresurus uetzi.The species, known from central and southern Myanmar, was unrecorded in India The discovery was made by scientists from Germany, Vietnam, and France in 2023. Trimeresurus uetzi is a cryptic species, difficult to differentiate from or very similar to 'Trimeresurus ervthrurus' species. However, DNA and scale examination revealed it as a different species. The new species possesses 21 dorsal mid-body scale rows, a green gold-colored iris, a grass green dorsum, a yellowish-green venter, a white postocular streak, and lack of red stripes on facial and ventrolateral regions. The discovery in Mizoram has revealed the richness of the state and adjacent region, the meeting point of the Indian Subcontinent and Southeast Asia due to continental drift, in biodiversity. With the discovery of the new species, the record of 20 Trimeresurus species in the country will now rise to 21 species, according to Lalremsanga. He said that there are four Trimeresurus species in Mizoram, including the newly discovered Trimeresurus uetzi and Trimeresurus mayaae, which was discovered from Champhai in 2022.

NDRF teams prepositioned in Cachar, Bongaigaon, Dibrugarh

Guwahati: The Assam government has taken extensive measures to ensure the safety and well-being of its citizens in light of the impending increase in rainfall and wind speeds due to Cyclone Remal, which will make landfall on May 26 in West Bengal and Bangladesh and move northwards towards the Northeast. The Indian Meteorological Department (IMD) has warned of extremely heavy rainfall over Assam along with other northeastern states on May 27 and 28. IMD has already issued red alert for extremely heavy rainfall in Chirang, Goalpara, Baksa, Dima Hasao, Cachar, Hailakandi and Karimganj districts and an orange alert for Dhubri, South Salmara, Bongaigaon, Bajali, Tamulpur, Barpeta, Nalbari, Morigaon, Nagaon, Hojai and West Karbi Anglong districts. Squally winds of



40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph are likely over South Assam and Meghalaya on May 27. According to the IMD bulletin at 5.30 pm on Sunday, the severe cyclonic Storm "Remal" (pronounced as Re-Mal) over the North Bay of Bengal moved nearly northwards, with a speed of 16 kmph during the past 06 hours, slightly intensified further and lay centred at 5.30 pm IST of Sunday over the same region near latitude 21.1°N and longitude 89.2°E about 130 km east-southeast of Sagar

Islands (West Bengal), 140 km southwest of Khepupara (Bangladesh), 140 km south-southeast of Canning (West Bengal) and 160 km south-southwest of Mongla (Bangladesh). The minimum distance from the Bangladesh and adjoining West Bengal coastline is about 70 km. "The Assam State Disaster Management Authority (ASDMA) has ramped up preparations along with other departments, agencies, and district administrations...

Cyclone Remal: PM Modi holds review meeting ahead of landfall

New Delhi: Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Sunday held a meeting to review the response and preparedness of the administration ahead of the cyclone Remal, which is set to make a landfall by midnight between Bangladesh and adjoining West Bengal coasts. According to IMD, the deep depression in the Bay of Bengal transformed into a cyclone on Saturday evening. Met department chief Mrutyunjay Mohapatra, the cyclone is centred in the Bay of Bengal 200 KMs south of Canning town in West Bengal. It is moving towards the north and will continue to hit the coast between Sagar



Island of West Bengal and Khepupara of Bangladesh. Rainfall started in coastal regions The precipitation has already started in the coastal districts which will intensify and exceed 25 cm today, he added. In addition to that, heavy rainfall of 7-10 cm has been predicted by IMD in Odisha's Bhadrak, Balasore. Kendrapara and Mayurbhanj districts. Taking

India likely to receive abovenormal monsoon rain this year

New Delhi: India's core monsoon zone. which covers most rain-fed agriculture areas, is predicted to receive above-normal rainfall this season, according to the India Meteorological Department (IMD). The region includes Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Mizoram, Odisha, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, and West Bengal. The IMD predicts normal rainfall in June. with normal to above-normal maximum temperatures expected in the country. However. normal rainfall does not guarantee uniform distribution of rain across the country due to climate change increasing variability. The monsoon is crucial for India's agricultural landscape, with 52% of the net cultivated area relying on it. Water storage in 150 major reservoirs in India dropped to 24% of their live storage last week, exacerbating water shortages and affecting hydropower generation.

6 die as Cyclone Remal ravages Bengal; heavy rain to continue

Kolkata: Two people died in West Bengal and its coastal areas after Cyclone Remal tore through the state and neighboring Bangladesh with wind speeds reaching 135 km per hour. The cyclone caused extensive damage to infrastructure and property, with roofs of thatched huts blown away, uprooted trees blocking roads, and electricity poles knocked down, causing significant power disruption in various parts of the state. Suburban train services from the Sealdah terminal station were partially suspended for at least three hours, while flight services at the Kolkata airport resumed after being suspended for 21 hours. The state government has initiated relief operations, providing food, drinking water, and medical assistance to the affected people. The authorities have urged residents to remain indoors and take necessary precautions until the heavy rain persists.

Severe cyclone 'Remal' barrels towards Bengal coast

Kolkata: Severe cyclonic storm 'Remal' has intensified and is expected to make landfall between the coasts of Bangladesh and adjoining West Bengal around Sunday midnight, prompting the evacuation of over 1 lakh people from vulnerable areas of the state to safety. Bengal's coastal areas have been put on high alert as the cyclone, accompanied by high-velocity winds, has already triggered rain in several parts of the state.

According to an India Meteorological Department (IMD) bulletin, the 'Remal' was centred 160 km south-southeast of Sagar Island at 6pm. The cyclone, which has a maximum sustained wind speed of 100-110 kmph, gusting to 120 kmph, is likely to hit land between Sagar Islands in West Bengal and Khepupara near Mongla port in Bangladesh by Sunday midnight, officials said. New Delhi: Media Chairman of the All India Congress Committee Pawan Khera said here on Sunday that Prime Minister Narendra Modi was lowering the level and dignity of his post. Severe cyclone 'Remal' barrels towards Bengal coast

Residents in the coastal regions of Bengal, urging them to adhere to the standard operating procedures (SOPs) for cyclones. The cyclone has already caused light rain and winds in areas like Digha, Kakdwip, and Jaynagar, which are expected to intensify on Monday. IMD's eastern regional head Somnath Dutta said from Sunday evening, districts in south Bengal would experience squally winds of 45-55 kmph, gusting to 65 kmph, affecting Kolkata, Howrah, Hooghly, and Purba Medinipur. "This will gradually increase to gale wind speed, reaching 70 to 80 kmph gusting to 90

kmph," he told reporters. Dutta warned that surface wind speeds in coastal areas of West Bengal could reach 100- 120 kmph, gusting to 135 kmph from Sunday evening to Monday morning. However, he mentioned that the damage caused by 'Remal' would be less severe compared to the destruction wrought by Super Cyclone Amphan in 2020. Amphan, which was categorised as a super cyclone, had made landfall on May 20 in 2020 over Sagar Island and caused widespread destruction in Kolkata South and North 24 Parganas, Howrah and

Modi will not become PM again, says Rahul in Bihar

Patna: Congress leader Rahul Gandhi on Monday hit out at Prime Minister Narendra Modi for using central agencies such as CBI, ED and IT against opposition leaders across the country and said that PM Modi has brought the story of 'Parmatma' to save himself from these agencies after the Lok Sabha elections. "You know why he (Modi) has brought this story of 'Parmatma' (God)? Because after the Lok Sabha elections, when ED will ask Narendra Modi about Adani, he will say, I don't know, I was asked to do so by 'Parmatma'," Rahul said while addressing a rally in Patna Saib Lok Sabha constituency in Bihar.He asked PM Modi to stop talking about such things in his election speeches. "Stop giving long speeches and deviding the country. First, tell me how many jobs you have given to the people of Bihar and to the country in the last 10 years," Rahul asserted. The Congress leader further claimed that Modi would not remain the PM after the election results come out on June 4. "You can note it down that Narendra Modi is not going to become the PM for the next term," he said to the gathering amid applause from the crowd He claimed that there was a 'toofan' (wave) in favour of the 'IN-DIA' bloc in Bihar and Uttar Pradesh. Earlier, in another rally in Bihar, Gandhi said that if 'INDIA' bloc comes to

power, each woman mem-



ber of a family would have Rs.8,500 deposited to their accounts per month. He also reiterated the promise of jobs for graduates in the country. Cyclone Remal: PM Modi holds review meeting ahead of landfall

Cyclone Remal caused significant damage in West Bengal, coastal Bangladesh, Tripura, and other northeastern states. The IMD forecasted that the cyclone will cause rainfall and strong winds. The low-pressure area first observed on May 22 in the Bay of Bengal has intensified into a more depressive system, now located in the North Bay of Bengal. The primary regions affected are West Bengal, Coastal Bangladesh, Tripura, and some other parts of north-eastern states. Residents in these areas and the neighboring state of Tripura are urged to brace for adverse weather conditions starting from May 26.

The Kolkata Airport Authority announced the suspension of flight operations for 21 hours due to Cyclone Remal's landfall. Authorities in West Bengal and Tripura are on guard to prepare for any eventualities arising from the cyclone. A National Disaster Response Force official in South 24 Parganas district of West Bengal stated that they are fully prepared to handle any kind of disaster. Authorities in Tripura are closely monitoring the situation and coordinating with the IMD for further developments regarding the cyclonic storm. District Magistrates are advised to follow the India Meteorological Department's (IMD) impact-based advisories and take appropriate measures. NDRF and other teams are ready to evacuate people from low-lying areas to safe shelters and start providing relief if needed.

The 26-year-old swashbuckling batter received limited opportunities in the season and contributed 168 runs at a strike rate of 148.67. However, he stuck to his quickfire approach throughout the campaign. Talking about their title-winning journey, Rinku credited the team effort behind their success in the tournament. "You can't credit just one person because everyone has worked hard. Since GG (Gautam Gambhir) sir came, a lot of things have



changed. Sending Sunil early, he batted so well. The batters played well, and the bowling was great. Venky (Venkatesh lyer) has been batting really well for the last five-six matches, so overall, everyone has done really well," he said. In the final, KKR's spirited bowling effort bundled Hyderabad for 113 as Andre Russell bagged three wickets while Mitchell Starc and Harshit Rana grabbed two scalps apiece. Venkatesh lyer's unbeaten 52* off 26 balls studded with four fours and three sixes while Rahmanullah Gurbaz scored 39 including five fours and two sixes as KKR chased the target in 10.3 overs. "When you're a part of this squad, not playing or not involved in the field, but supporting the guys all the way, it's always a good feeling, but this is a special feeling. In the XI, playing a part in the Final, contributing as well through my

leadership and everything, it's an exciting feeling. It's special." Russell said. "I always enjoy playing here. So, if the bowler bowls wide, I push straight and I have access because I am standing on the off-stump."

Rowllin Borges, who was an integral part of the ISL double-winning squad in 2020/21, will conclude his five-year stint with Mumbai City FC at the end of this month. Tondomba Singh, on loan at Delhi FC, will leave the club after four seasons. Jakub Vojtuš, who joined the team in March 2024 on a shortterm contract, will also depart upon the expiration of his contract.

Mumbai: Mitchell Starc, a champion left-arm fast bowler, put his team, Kolkata Knight Riders (KKR), in command with two strikes in his opening burst. His teammates, Rahmanullah Gurbaz and Venkatesh Iyer, secured the third IPL title with a dominating display with the bat. Iver, who had 318 runs before the fall of Sunil Narine, did not spare anyone, and Gurbaz made a solid 39 off 32 balls with 5 x 4s and 2 x 6s. In the presence of 33,061 spectators, KKR crossed the finishing line—a target of 114—in 63 balls, with lyer unbeaten on 52 (26b, 4 x 4s, 3 x 6s).

Starc was declared the Man of the Match. Bought at a staggering and all-time most expensive IPL player at Rs.24.75 crore, Starc began with an analysis of 4-0-511-0 in the first match against the Sunrisers and 4-0-47-0 in the second match against

the Royal Challengers Bengaluru. He showed his class in the next three matches but went for 50 and 55 runs in the next two against the Rajasthan Royals and RCB. The Australian ran into form with a 4 for 33 against Mumbai Indians. However, what mattered most to his team was his 3 for 34 against the Sunrisers in the qualifier 1 match in Ahmedabad.

In the tournament final against a team that KKR was playing for the third time in the Tata-IPL-17, Starc ran amok, taking the wicket of left-hander Abhishek Sharma in the fifth ball of the first over after Pat Cummins chose to bat upon winning the toss. The Sunrisers' score looked dismal in the first six over powerplay, but a small partnership of 23 between Cummins and Jaydev Unadkat took the team past the 100-run mark.

Diksha lies ninth in LET Order of Merit

Mumbai: Diksha Dagar was lying ninth on the Ladies European Tour's Order of Merit after a creditable T-20 finish at the Jabra Ladies Open. Diksha, who had rounds of 72-72 in the first two rounds, shot even par 71 on the final day for a total of 2-over 215. Diksha had two birdies and two bogeys at Evian Resort Golf Club in France. Diksha, who was third last vear on the Order of Merit, is ninth with a good part of the season and some big events still to come.lt was Diksha's fifth Top-20 finish, three of which have been Top-20. She has also had two other Top25 finishes. Overall in nine starts, she has been Top-25 seven times and missed the cut only once. Diksha, who plays next week in Sweden for the Dormy Open Helsingborg, was the only Indian of the six to make the cut this week. Morgane Metraux of Switzerland overcame a shaky start to

the final round on Saturday to claim her second Ladies European Tour title. After completing a second round of seven-under-par 64 on Saturday morning, Metraux bogeyed three of her first four holes in the final round and her six-stroke lead was down to just one stroke after 12. However, her closest challenger, Agathe Sauzon of France, missed the green and dropped a shot on the 13th. Metraux took her opportunity and birdied the next three holes, starting with a near hole-out on the tough par-3 14th. The round of one-over 72 gave Metraux a winning total of 10-under-par and a threeshot victory over Sauzon and Swiss compatriot Chiara Tamburlini. Ireland's Lauren Walsh ended three strokes further back in solo fourth.In the Order of Merit. Metraux jumps to 11th on 525.94 points. Her compatriot, Tamburlini, moves to third on 1,109.10 points.
