# Modi government set to introduce major amendments to Waqf Act

New Delhi: In a move likely to spark heated debates and become a significant political issue for the Opposition, the Modi government is reportedly preparing to introduce a Bill in Parliament proposing 40 amendments to the Waqf Act. The proposed amendments received the NDA-III government's nod during a late evening meeting of the Union Cabinet on Friday. Though no official statement has been released by the government yet, sources and two Delhi dailies have reported that the Bill could be presented in Parliament this week. The amendments aim to address longstanding issues surrounding the administration of waqf properties, which are among the country's largest landholdings. The proposed amendments are part of a broader strategy by the NDA-III government under Prime Minister Narendra Modi. If the Bill is moved in Parliament, it would seek to establish stricter guidelines for the declaration and management of waqf lands, ensuring greater transparency and accountability. Key provisions of the likely Bill may include the appointment



of independent auditors to review the administration of waqf properties and quidelines for waaf lands. Speculation also suggests the amendments may propose enhanced powers for the central government to intervene in cases of significant mismanagement or fraud. Sources in the government suggest that this legislative move is designed to address concerns raised by various stakeholders about the effectiveness of current regulations. The bill is expected to spark a heated debate in Parliament, with supporters arguing that these reforms are necessary for better governance, while opponents view it as an infringement on religious autonomy. Currently, 30 Waqf Boards operate across India's 28 states and Union

Territories, following the enactment of the Waqf Act, 1995, which was designed to streamline "Auqaf" (property owned by Waqf Boards). The Bill may propose fresh verification of boards' assets. In 2023, the Delhi High Court directed the Central Government to carry out a physical verification of 123 properties owned by the Delhi Waqf Board in the national capital. Additionally, the Bill may propose ensuring a reservation for women in the Central and State Waqf Boards by mandating verification of land before it is declared waqf property. This significant legislative move is poised to be a focal point in the upcoming parliamentary sessions, highlighting the ongoing debate between governance

## 373 Wayanad Rescue operations enter people to be airlifted from Lincholi

Lucknow: Over 370 peoincluding devotees ple, and locals stranded on the rain-ravaged trek route to Kedarnath, have been evacuated and sent to Lincholi to be airlifted as the rescue operation entered its fourth day. Chief Executive Officer of Shri Badrinath Kedarnath Temple Committee Yogendra Singh said that these 373 people who left from Kedarnath with rescuers, including teams of SDRF and NDRF, for Lyncholi from where they will be airlifted to safer places via helicopter. Meanwhile, 570 passengers are also waiting for the helicopter at Kedarnath helipad. Singh said the district administration, temple committee and Tirtha Purohit Samaj are providing food packets, water bottles and fruits to all the people stranded in Kedarnath. According to officials, 110 pilgrims stranded on the Rambada-Chaumasi track have also been evacuated and taken to Chaumasi. More than 534 pilgrims and locals have been evacuated from this route so far. The trek route to Kedarnath suffered extensive damage as a result of a cloudburst in Junglechatti near Lincholi on Wednesday night. Roads were washed away at many places, including Lincholi,

Bhimbali. Ghorapadav and Rambada, on the Kedarnath trek route. At some other locations, roads were damaged due to landslides and large stones falling from the hill, due to which pilgrims were stranded at many places. Personnel of the SDRF. NDRF .The Indian Air Force's Chinook and MI17 helicopters airlifted some pilgrims from the area on Friday. So far, about 10,000 people have been evacuated. Meanwhile, the construction of a footbridge has been started by the Army on the washed away road between SonprayagGaurikund on the Kedarnath National Highway. Rudraprayag district administration officials said the help of two sniffer dogs will now be taken in the rescue operation going on on the Kedarnath route. They said that this operation will be carried out with the help of the Army. According to officials, the sniffer dog squad has landed in Lincholi Helipad, from where it will start searching the entire area. Officials believe that many people would have moved towards the forests to save their lives due to fear of rain and during this time, search will be conducted in such areas as the possibility of them getting lost is high.

Kerala, still recovering from the devastating Wayanad landslide that claimed over 300 lives, is expected to experience heavy rainfall at isolated places until August 5.

## Election Commission denounces 'false campaign' discrediting Lok Sabha polls

New Delhi: In a statement released on social media platform X, the ECI asserted that certain groups, not including candidates, are attempting to discredit the elections, which it described as the largest and most transparent in history. The Election Commission of India (ECI) has strongly refuted allegations of discrepancies in the 2024 Lok Sabha elections, labeling the claims as part of a 'false campaign' aimed at undermining the credibility of the polls.In a statement released on social media platform X, the ECI asserted that certain groups, not including candidates, are attempting to discredit the elections, which it described as the largest and most transparent in history. The poll body emphasized that these attempts are based on comparing the preliminary voter turnout at 7 PM on polling day with the final turnout figures, which are released

the following day."False campaign is being run by some (other than candidates) in furtherance of design to discredit largest elections ever held in the history of mankind in a most transparent manner involving candidates/ stakeholders at every stage of elections," the ECI posted.The Commission clarified that comparing the initial approximate turnout figures with the final numbers is misleading, as many polling stations are still processing voters at 7 PM. The official end-of-poll turnout is calculated and made available only after all votes are counted, usually the day after polling ends. The ECI further highlighted that the legitimate way to contest an electoral outcome is through an Election Petition under the Representation of the People Act, 1951. It noted that the number of such petitions has decreased in the 2024 General Elections compared to the 2019 elections. The controversy arose after Congress leader Sandeep Dikshit, citing a report by Vote for Democracy (VFD) Maharashtra, called for the ECI to address alleged discrepancies in the voter turnout. The VFD report, released in Mumbai, claimed significant inconsistencies between the votes polled and counted, as well as an unexplained increase in turnout percentages.

In response to Congress MLA Ranjit Singh's question about violence occurring despite the presence of over 38,000 state forces, Singh said, "An investigation is being conducted by a retired Supreme Court judge. The findings will identify the lapses that contributed to the violence, and responsibility will be fixed based on the inquiry's conclusions." Replying to a query from Congress MLA Surajkumar Okram, Singh said, "So far, 226 people have been killed in the violence. There have been delays in arresting culprits in certain cases due to mob-like conditions. There have also been instances of groups obstructing security forces."
