BJP attacks INDIA Bloc over Badlapur encounter

Badlapur: Reacting to the INDIA bloc's attack over the encounter killing of the Badlapur sexual assault accused, the Bharatiya Janata Party on Tuesday called the opposition's group "Balatkari bachao alliance" The accused, Akshay Shinde, was shot dead by the police on Monday night after he allegedly snatched a policeman's gun and fired at them. The opposition has called for a probe into the encounter. "Badlapur sexual assault accused Akshay Shinde died after being shot at by police in retaliatory firing. On one hand, Maharashtra and Badlapur have taken a sigh of relief whereas on the other hand. parties of the INDI alliance are mourning the death of a rapist. Is this a 'balatkari bachao alliance'?" said BJP spokesperson Shehzad Poonawalla. Attacking the Mamata Banerjee government, he said the INDI alliance tried to save the accused in the RG Kar Medical College and Hospital rape-murder.

Indian Govt denies PM Modi's meeting with Trump

PM Modi meeting Trump or Harris was never on his itinerary

New Delhi: Even though Republican Presidential candidate Donald Trump claimed that Prime Minister Narendra Modi was meeting him in New York during his three day US visit, the Indian leader never had meetings with either Trump or Democrat Presidential candidate Kamala Harris on his agenda. PM Modi is on his way back home after attending the QUAD summit and speaking at "Future of UN" summit. While pro-Democrat media has tried to make this into 'PM Modi snubs Trump campaign', the fact is that Trump's claim of meeting Modi caught the Prime Minister's Office and the Ministry of External Affairs by surprise as the Indian leader had sought no meeting with either Trump or Vice President Harris.

"India is absolutely comfortable with either Democrats or Republicans coming to power. This is a bipartisan relationship since



the time of Bill Clinton and the two countries are constantly in touch with each other with deep converdence on bilateral issues PM Modi has no desire to promote one candidate against the other as this would be construed as election interference in a poll bound country," said a former foreign secretary. The Indian response was totally opposite from behavior of US diplomats who landed in Srinagar to meet Opposition party leadership in the poll bound UT. Just as the left-liberal media has made an issue out of non-existent Trump-Modi meeting, another issue was made out after National Security Advisor Ajit Doval dropped out of PM Modi's delegation to US due to legal threats from a rabid Khalistani based in New York. Fact is that NSA Doval did not go with the PM as the prime focus of the visit would be deliberately changed by the liberal media with the Khalistani agenda coming on the front burner.

There are no less than half a million Sikhs in the US and the majority of them are Democrat voters in stronghold states of California, Washington and New York. The NSA on his part was involved in monitoring the Sri Lankan elections and the crisis in Bangladesh. While External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar will take up the disrespect shown by rabid Khalistanis to Indian flag and leadership during PM Modi visit when he visits Washington after addressing UNGA on September 26, the Indian national security planners are not at all perturbed by these legal threats and it is business as usual.

The Modi government is clear that India's rise will be contested by all powers including those who are called strategic partners, but New Delhi is not cowed down by few rabid protestors and will respond in kind at time and place of its choosing.

Badlapur rape accused's body taken to Mumbai

MUMBAI: Akshay Shinde's body is being taken to Mumbai. The autopsy will be conducted in a hospital in Mumbai. He was shot dead by police on Monday after he snatched an officer's weapon and opened fire at the cops. Two police officials were also injured in the incident. Police said the accused was being taken in a vehicle when he snatched Assistant Police Inspector Nilesh More's pistol and fired at the escorting police team, injuring three cops. Shinde, who worked as a sweeper in the Badlapur school where he sexually abused two girls.

Modi meets Zelensky in US •New York: Prime Min-

ister Narendra Modi met Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy in New York on the sidelines of UNGA and reiterated India's support for the early resolution of the conflict in Ukraine and the restoration of peace and stability in the region.

3 railway employees arrested

Surat: Three railway employees were arrested on Monday for allegedly sabotaging rail tracks in Gujarat's Surat district. The employees later alerted the authorities about the incident. They wanted a night shift so that they could spend more time with their families during the day, the police said. They also wanted felicitation from their seniors. The three employees allegedly conspired to derail a train near Kim railway station by removing fishplates and keys from a railway track. The attempt was thwarted.

Israeli PM Netanyahu urges Lebanese civilian to evacuate

Jerusalem: Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, in a recorded message, urged Lebanese civilians to heed their calls to evacuate, ahead of its widening air campaign against Hezbollah, news agency AP reported. "Israel's war is not with you. It's with Hezbollah. For too long, Hezbollah has been using you as human shields ... Starting this morning, the IDF has warned you to get out of harm's way. I urge you, take this warning seriously. Don't let Hezbollah endanger your lives and the lives of your loved ones... Once our operation is finished, you can come back safely to your homes," Netanyahu said. The warning comes after Israel unleashed its most widespread wave of airstrikes against hundreds of Hezbollah targets, killing

492 people, including 35 children and 58 women. and wounding 1,645 by Lebanese tallies, AP report stated. This marked the deadliest attack in Lebanon since 2006. The latest attacks come amid some of the heaviest cross-border exchanges of fire in almost a year of conflict, as Israel shifts its focus to its northern border, where Hezbollah has been firing rockets into Israel in support of its ally Hamas, which is fighting a war with Israel in Gaza. Just after the pager and walkie talkie attack in Lebanon that claimed the lives of some Hezbollah leaders, Israeli military launched airstrikes in Beirut last week, the most recent being the one that killed Ibrahim Aqil, a senior leader in Hezbollah's elite Radwan Force.

Karnataka HC rejects CM Siddaramaiah's plea against Guv's sanction for probe

Bangalore: The Karnataka High Court has rejected a petition from Chief Minister Siddaramaiah that challenged Governor Taawarchand Gehlot's approval for prosecution against him in the Mysuru Urban Development Authority (MUDA) scam case. CM Siddaramaiah is facing investigation for alleged illegalities in MUDA allotting as many as 14 sites to his wife in the prime location of Mysuru city. The verdict was given by Justice M Nagaprasanna at 12 pm today. This comes after the High Court's interim order on August 19, which provided temporary relief to the CM by instructing a special court in Bengaluru to postpone any further action regarding the prosecution sanction granted by the Governor. Gov-



ernor Gehlot had sought a detailed report from the state government on Thursday regarding a complaint that claimed MUDA carried out projects valued at 387 crore in breach of regulations, reportedly following verbal directives from Siddaramaiah. On August 31, the Karnataka Governor's office informed the high court that the approval to prosecute Chief Minister Siddaramaiah over the alleged MUDA scam was granted after careful consideration, based on three petitions filed by individuals T J Abraham, Pradeep and Snehamayi Krishna. Amid controversy surrounding the Governor's decision to allow the prosecution of CM Siddaramaiah, state ministers and several other Congress workers participated in a 'Raj Bhavan Chalo' protest.

Shillong Airport Expansion Underway Amid Regulatory Challenges



Shillong: The Meghalaya government is driving forward with plans to upgrade Shillong Airport at Umroi, aiming to accommodate larger aircraft and boost regional connectivity. Deputy Chief Minister Sniawbhalang Dhar, in charge of transport, revealed key details following a site inspection and high-level meeting with aviation officials. A recent report from the Air-

recent report from the Airport Authority of India (AAI) has identified potential for expansion, focusing on extending the runway by 900 meters to the south, avoid-ing environmental concerns and nearby hill cutting ¹. However, the project fac-

es regulatory challenges, with Dhar emphasizing the need for exemptions from central government guidelines to make expansion feasible. The state cabinet will review and potentially approve the land acquisition plan. Without exemptions, costs could soar to Rs 8,000 crore, potentially derailing the project.

This development follows previous collaborations between the Meghalaya government and AAI to explore expansion possibilities. The Meghalaya High Court has also directed the government and AAI to complete inspections for runway extension.

Nagaland police seize over 9,500 bottles of illegal liquor in state-wide crackdown



Kohima: In a coordinated state-wide operation aimed at curbing the sale and storage of illegal liquor, the Nagaland Police carried out surprise inspections across the state on September 21, 2024, under the provisions of the Nagaland Liquor Total Prohibition (NLTP) Act of 1989. The operation, conducted by various District Executive Forces (DEFs) and NAP/IR Battalions, resulted in the seizure of 9,583 bottles of liquor of various brands, highlighting the ongoing issue of liquor trafficking in the state. During the two-hour drive, police registered 28 cases across multiple police stations and arrested 30 individuals under Section 44 (e) of the NLTP Act. The crackdown, which was meticulously planned and executed, was part of the Nagaland Police's broader efforts to enforce the Liquor Prohibition Act and eliminate the illegal liquor trade.

"BJP Will form govt in Jharkhand": Sarma Himanta Biswa Sarma asserts BJP's

Himanta Biswa Sarma asserts BJP's readiness for Jharkhand elections

Guwahati: Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma made a key political statement regarding the upcoming Jharkhand Assembly elections. Sarma stated that while the Election Commission of India will decide the date for the elections, the BJP is fully prepared for the electoral battle.

Sarma emphasized that the BJP is ready to contest the elections and has already begun strategic discussions with regional parties like the All Jharkhand Students Union (AJSU) and



Janata Dal (United).

It is to be mentioned here that these alliances aim to strengthen the BJP's position in Jharkhand. The Assam CM mentioned that the public sentiment in Jharkhand is leaning towards change, indicating that the BJP sees an opportunity to challenge the incumbent government and offer fresh leadership.

The ongoing negotiations with parties such as AJSU and JD(U) signal the BJP's intention to build a strong electoral coalition, similar to its approach in other states where regional alliances play a pivotal role.

The BJP, under Sarma's leadership, is ramping up its political efforts across various states, positioning itself as a key contender in the upcoming Jharkhand Assembly elections.

Arunachal Pradesh Governor adopts two tuberculosis patients

Itanagar: Arunachal Pradesh Governor Lt. General KT Parnaik (Retd.) has taken a personal stance against tuberculosis by adopting two patients from the remote Kra Daadi District. During his landmark visit to the area, Governor Parnaik interacted with one of the patients in Tali, committing to provide monthly food baskets as part of the Pradhan Mantri TB Mukt Bharat Abhiyan. The governor's visit marked the first time a state governor has reached the remote administrative circles of Pipsorang and Tali. He used this opportunity to review development programs and engage directly with villagers from Vibrant Border Villages. Emphasising the importance of community involvement, Governor Parnaik appealed to the public, especially those with the means, to adopt TB patients. He reminded listeners of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's goal to eliminate TB in India by 2025, five years ahead of the global target. The governor stressed the need for health officials to conduct door-to-door awareness campaigns and urged government officials to motivate public participation in the TB eradication initiative. He also highlighted the potential of using drones to deliver medicines in remote areas like Pipsorang. During his tour, Governor Parnaik re-



viewed progress on various development projects, focusing on four priority sectors: health, education, infrastructure, and tourism. He called for the presence of at least four basic specialists in district hospitals and advised education officials to address the issue of school dropouts.

The governor promoted the idea of adopting a Bhutanese model of tourism to encourage entrepreneurship and self-employment among youth. He also emphasised the importance of technology and automation in improving project planning and execution.

PNB, SBI, UCO: JM Financial lists 11 PSU bank stocks worth buying after selloff

New Delhi: A sharp decline in PSU bank stocks following the 2024 general election results has created a fresh buying opportunity, according to JM Financial. The brokerage expects the PSU Bank index to outperform the Nifty in the near future, highlighting 11 banks as strong contenders.

Since reaching its 52week high, the PSU Bank index has dropped by 15%, with banks like UCO Bank, Bank of India (BOI), Indian Overseas Bank (IOB), and Union Bank of India seeing sharper declines of 25-30%.

Other major players such as Punjab National Bank (PNB), Central Bank of India. Bank of Baroda (BOB). and Bank of Maharashtra fell between 18-22%, while Indian Bank. Canara Bank, and State Bank of India (SBI) experienced more modest declines of 12-15%. Despite these losses, JM Financial sees signs of recovery. The index, which recently dipped to 8,053 levels, found support around its 200-day exponential moving average (EMA) and has since rebounded, indicating further



strength.

The brokerage believes that this significant drop offers an opportunity for investors to reconsider PSU bank stocks, forecasting that the index is set to outperform the broader Nifty index in the months ahead "We believe this significant drop offers an opportunity to re-evaluate the sector, with expectations that the PSU Bank index is more likely to outperform the Nifty in the future," the brokerage said. Historically, the PSU Bank index has performed well in October and November. noted JM Financial. Over the past decade, the index has posted positive returns seven and eight times, with average gains of 7% and 6%, respectively. In the previous correction phase

between December 2022 and March 2023, the index similarly found support around its 200-day EMA before staging a robust recovery. The brokerage said key technical levels indicate that the index faces immediate resistance at 7,083, a crucial point above which it could negate its current trend of lower highs and lower lows. "Support in the index continues to prevail at 6,500-6,600 levels, coinciding with its 200-day EMA zone. The range further coincides with the support zone observed during the period February 2024, March 2024 and June 2024," it said. In the derivatives (F&O) market, there has been a notable lack of aggressive selling, with no significant rise in cumulative futures open interest.

Sensex and Nifty have reached fresh all-time high levels as the market continues to rise

Mumbai: Sensex and Nifty hit fresh all-time high levels in early trade amid a sharp rally in Asian markets and buying in IT stocks. The BSE Sensex climbed 202.3 points to reach an all-time record peak of 85,372.17 in early trade. The NSE Nifty went up 51.85 points to hit a fresh lifetime high of 26,056. From the 30 Sensex firms, Maruti, Nestle, Tata Motors, Infosys, Tech Mahindra, HCL Tech-

nologies, Bajaj Finserv, Tata Consultancy Services, ITC, and Bharti Airtel were the biggest gainers. Power Grid, NTPC, Tata Steel, and JSW Steel were among the laggards. In Asian markets, Seoul, Tokyo, Shanghai, and Hong Kong were trading with significant gains. The US markets ended mostly lower on Wednesday. Foreign Institutional Investors (FIIs) offloaded equities worth ₹973.94 crore on Wednesday while Domestic Institutional Investors (DIIs) were buyers as they bought equities



worth ₹1,778.99 crore, as per exchange data. "There are no immediate near-term triggers that can take the market sharply up or down. Up moves may attract selling by FIIs who are likely to move some more money to China and Hong Kong since these markets are cheap and are witnessing an uptrend now," said V K Vijayakumar, Chief Investment Strategist, Geojit Financial Services. But FII selling is unlikely to push the market down significantly since the ample domestic liquidity can easily absorb such selling, Vijayakumar said.

Fintech loan disbursements decline in volume and value in Q1FY25

Mumbai: For the first time in over four quarters, the volume and value of credit disbursements among fintech companies declined marginally on a quarter-on-quarter (Q-o-Q) basis, data from a self-regulatory organisation for fintechs (SRO-FT) show.

Disbursement volumes declined 0.75 per cent to 26.4 million disbursements in the first quarter of financial year 2025 (Q1FY25) compared to 26.6 million in Q4FY24. However, on a year-onyear (Y-o-Y) basis, loans grew 14.8 per cent from 23 million disbursements in Q1FY24, data from the Fintech Association for Consumer Empowerment (FACE) show.

On a Q-o-Q basis, the value of disbursements slipped marginally to Rs 37,676 crore in Q1FY25 from Rs 39,580 crore in Q4FY24. On a Y-o-Y basis, disbursements grew 27.5 per cent from Rs 29,556 crore in Q1FY24.

The signs of a slowdown in disbursements come nearly one year after the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) hiked risk weights on unsecured loans.

In Q1FY25, the average ticket size of a loan was pegged at Rs 12,997. "Member companies responsibly meet customers' credit needs within the regulatory guardrails of customer protection and prudent risk management, earning the trust of the customers and stakeholders. Data signal the industry's adaptability to overall macro conditions and alignment with the policy objectives," said Sugandh Saxena, chief executive officer (CEO), FACE.

How listening to loud music can lead to hearing disorders

he widespread use earphones and of headphones, especially among younger generations, is becoming a serious public health concern. With many young individuals frequently exposed to loud music for extended periods, the risk of developing noise-induced hearing disorders is on the rise. What was once considered an issue for older populations has now begun affecting people in their teens and twenties, with long-term consequences that are often irreversible.

Noise-induced hearing loss (NIHL) occurs when the hair cells within the cochlea, a structure in the inner ear, are damaged by excessive sound.

According to the World Health Organisation (WHO), 1.1 billion teenagers and young adults worldwide are at risk of hearing loss due to unsafe listening practices. This includes exposure to loud

music through earphones, eswhen pecially used for prolonged periods at high volumes. "Short-term is-

sues caused by using earphones include excessive earwax build-up that can extend deep into the ear canal, leading to infections and earaches. The tight fit of earphones may also cause discomfort, pain,

and itching. In more acute cases, loud music can result in a Temporary Threshold Shift, causing temporary hearing loss," said Dr Amit Kumar Sharma, HOD

& Senior Consultant, ENT, Cochlear Implant & Voice Disorders, SHALBY Sanar International Hospitals,

Studies have shown that many young people listen to music at volumes exceeding 85 decibels (dB),



Gurugram. One of the most significant contributors to NIHL in younger populations is the volume at which music is played.

the threshold at which damage to hearing can occur. Regular exposure to sound levels above 85 dB can lead to permanent hearing damage. Alarmingly, some earphones can produce sounds as loud as 100 to 110 dB. levels that can cause hearing damage in just a few minutes

of exposure. Dr Sharma said that the long-term use of earphones, especially at high volumes, can result in permanent hear-

ing impairment. "Patients may also experience tinnitus, a constant ringing or buzzing in the ears, and hyperacusis, an increased sensitivity to everyday sounds. Poor earphone hygiene increases the risk of fungal ear infections, such as

otomvcosis. Prolonaed listening can also cause hearing fatigue, reducing overall hearing sensitivity, the expert said. Preventing hearing loss requires

awareness and action. The World Health Organisation (WHO) recommends following the "60/60 rule," which advises limiting music to no more than 60% of maximum volume for no longer than 60 minutes at a time. "Keep the volume at or below 60% of the maximum level, taking regular breaks, probably after listening to loud music from a duration of 60 to 90 minutes. Choose to wear comfortable well-fitted earphones. Clean your earphones regularly and get regular hearing tests done. Avoid sharing your earphones and limit your listening time," advised Dr Sharma.

Barcelona extend perfect start in La Liga with 6th win Ter Stegen loses



Bercelona: Barcelona extended its perfect start to the Spanish league season but lost goalkeeper Marc-André ter Stegen with a serious knee injury on Sunday. Barcelona routed host Villarreal 5-1 to pick up its sixth straight victory in the competition, but saw captain Ter Stegen leave the match on a stretcher just before halftime after his right knee buckled when he fell awkwardly after going up for a ball crossed into the area.

Barcelona president Joan Laporta said the injury appeared to be a torn ligament but more tests would be conducted. Local media reports said Ter Stegen went from the stadium to the hospital in an ambu-

lance, and left the hospital in a wheelchair. "This injury makes us sad. I think the injury will be huge but we have to wait for more information," Barcelona coach Hansi Flick said. "We have to accept it. It's not easy. It was an accident. It's very tough." Players from both teams immediately called for medical assistance after Ter Stegen fell to the ground in pain. He was replaced by reserve goalkeeper Iñaki Peña. Real Madrid goalkeeper Thibaut Courtois, who missed most of last season with a similar injury, showed his support to Ter Stegen with a message on X, saying that it hurt to see his colleague leave the field like that and that he hoped

he would recover soon.

Steve Smith hails Bumrah as best all-format bowler



New Delhi: Senior Australia batter Steve Smith hailed Jasprit Bumrah as the best all-format bowler. Speaking ahead of the Border-Gavaskar Trophy on Star Sports, Smith said that Bumrah challenged batters with both new and the old ball. The five-Test series between India and Australia begins in Perth on November 22. India has won the past two series Down Under. If India is to achieve a three-peat, Bumrah's rare skills will be heavily relied upon in Australia. "He's a wonderful bowler, whether I face him with the new ball.

Smith, a veteran of 109 Tests, is close to the milestone of 10,000 runs. The batter would need to bat out of his skin to achieve the record. Smith has 9,685 runs at the moment in Test cricket.

India continue to dominate, Sri Lanka advance in World Test Championship standing

Mumbai: The ICC released an updated World Test Championship list after the conclusion of India's 1st Test vs Bangladesh and Sri Lanka's Test match against New Zealand, India continued their domination at the top of the rankings with an emphatic win by 280 runs against Bangladesh at the MA Chidambaram Stadium in Chennai. India have played 10 Tests in the 2023-25 cycle and won 7 and lost 2 with 2 draws to their name. The Rohit Sharma-led Indian team has 86 points with a win percentage of 71.67%. India have further solidified their chances to reach the third consecutive final of the World Test Championship, which will be played at the Lord's Cricket Ground in London in July 2025. India have nine remaining Tests for the ongoing WTC cycle and four wins and a draw should be



enough for them to reach the final. India's best possible finish could be 85.09%.

Sri Lanka also made significant advancement in the World Test Championship points table. They trumped New Zealand to acquire the No. 3 spot of the rankings with Australia holding the No. 2 spot. Sri Lanka beat New Zealand by 63 runs in their 1st home Test at Galle. The island nation has played 8 matches so far and managed to win four and lose four. They currently have 48 points with a win percentage of 50%. New Zealand slumped to 4th spot with their loss as they have four defeats in seven Tests so far with three wins. Bangladesh's big defeat pushed them down to the sixth spot in the stands with a percentage of 39.29% as they stood behind Sri Lanka, New Zealand and England in the points table. Sri Lanka's win made them strong contenders for a spot in the WTC final. With a potential maximum percentage of 69.23%, they will now need a clean sweep against South Africa, followed by a 2–0 series win over Australia at home, to secure their place in the final. In the WTC 2023-2025, teams will get 12 points for a win, 4 for a draw and 6 for a tie.

In land of Polgars, Indian women make history

Bengaluru: The Indian women's team stood outside the Budapest Olympic Sports and Conference centre after their final-round win on Sunday, overjoyed, but wary of a jinx. Now a veteran, she has seen the arc of Indian women's chess - from being one of two female GMs alongside Koneru Humpy to watching Vaishali Rameshbabu join them and this wave of young players stepping up at the Olym-

m piad.

It's taken a while but Harika finally has the gold she dreamt of, that saw her show up for the tournament last time well into her final trimester of pregnancy. USA denied them the gold two years ago after India went into the final round in sole lead. This time around, Harika hasn't exactly had a great run on the top board, but a win on the final day and a gold in her cabin baggage should do. India went into the final round in a shared lead with Kazakhstan. India bludgeoned Azerbaijan 3.5-0.5 and other results too went their way.
