Army foils infiltration bid, neutralizes Pakistani intruder in Pathankot, Punjab

Pathankot, Feb 26: Alert Border Security Force (BSF) troops successfully foiled an infiltration attempt along the International Border (IB) in Pathankot, Punjab, during the early hours of February 26.

According to officials, BSF personnel stationed at the BOP Tashpatan border area observed suspicious movement across the IB. An unidentified intruder



was spotted attempting to cross into Indian territory.

Despite being challenged by the alert troops, the intruder continued advancing, ignoring repeated warnings. Sensing a potential threat, BSF troops took action and neutralised the infiltrator.

Authorities are working to ascertain the identity and motive of the intruder. Meanwhile, BSF has confirmed that a strong protest will be lodged with the Pakistan Rangers over the attempted infiltration.

Delhi govt incurred losses of ₹2,000 cr due to liquor policy

New Delhi, Feb 25: The Delhi government suffered cumulative losses of over Rs 2,000 crore due to the 2021-2022 excise policy for reasons ranging from weak policy framework to deficient implementation, according to a CAG report tabled in the assembly on Tuesday.

The report, one of 14 on the previous Aam Aadmi Party government's performance to be tabled by the new Rekha Gup-

ta-led dispensation, has also flagged violations in the process of issuing licences. It has pointed out that recommendations of an expert panel, formed to suggest changes for the formation of the now scrapped policy, were ignored by then deputy chief minister and excise minister Manish Sisodia. The report on the alleged liquor scam, a hot button issue in the run-up to the elections.

Atishi and 11 AAP MLAs suspended from Delhi Assembly for creating uproar

New Delhi, Feb 25: Delhi Speaker Vijender Gupta on Tuesday expelled 12 Aam Aadmi Party MLAs, including Leader of Opposition Atishi and Gopal Rai, for the day from the assembly for raising slogans during Lieutenant Governor VK Saxena's address.

Veer Singh Dhingan, Mukesh Ahlawat, Chaudhary Zubair Ahmed, Anil Jha, Vishesh Ravi and Jarnail Singh are among the other AAP leaders expelled



from the assembly. Atishi alleged that the Bharatiya Janata Party had disrespected BR Ambedkar by removing his portrait from the chief minister's office.

"The BJP has shown its true colours by removing Babasaheb Ambedkar's portrait. Does it believe

Modi can replace Babasaheb?" Atishi said at a press conference. The former chief minister alleged that the BJP-led administration had removed Ambedkar's portraits from the chief minister's office in both the Delhi Secretariat and the assembly. The development comes even as the New BJP-led Delhi government to present 14 Comptroller and Auditor General reports in the 2nd session of the assembly

ED raids in ₹600 crore crypto scam

New Delhi, Feb 25: The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has conducted raids in several cities, including Delhi, Jaipur, and Mumbai, under the Foreign Exchange Management Act (FEMA) in connection with a Rs 600 crore cryptocurrency conversion case. So far, bank accounts containing Rs 2.18 crore belonging to the accused have been frozen.

13 FIRs filed against 140 social media accounts for spreading misinformation

Prayagraj, Feb 24 More than a dozen First Information Reports (FIRs) have been filed against 140 social media handles for spreading 'misleading content' about the ongoing Maha Kumbh in Uttar Pradesh's Prayagraj, police said

"13 FIRs have been registered against 140 social media handles that shared misleading content," Maha Kumbh DIG Vaibhav Krishna told. The Uttar Pradesh Police's social media cell has been keeping a close eye on social media platforms, particularly after objectionable videos of women pilgrims taking bath in the Triveni Sangam, were shared there.

Meanwhile, with a massive influx of devotees expected on February 26, the Maha Kumbh's last day, due to the festival of Maha



Shivratri, DIG Krishna said 'complete arrangements' have been made for the festival.

"Efforts will be made to ensure that there is no traffic jam anywhere in the Maha Kumbh area. All arrangements should run smoothly. No matter how big the crowd is, we are fully prepared," he said.

Uttar Pradesh chief minister Yogi Adityanath said 62 crore pilgrims have already taken a holy dip in the Triveni Sangam (meeting point of rivers Ganga, Yamuna and the legendary Saraswati) in Prayagraj.

The information department of the Uttar Pradesh government reported that on Sunday, nearly 8.7 million (87 lakh) people had taken the holy dip. The Maha Kumbh began on January 13. Authorities managing the Maha Kumbh crowd at the Ayodhya Dham railway station in Ayodhya.

US avoids blaming Russia for Ukraine, causing rift with EU allies in UN votes

U.S. stance on Russia sparks discord with European allies at U.N.

United Nations, Feb 25: In a dramatic shift in transatlantic relations under President Donald Trump, the United States split with its European allies by refusing to blame Russia for its invasion of Ukraine in votes on three UN resolutions Monday seeking an end to the three-year war.

The growing divide follows Trump's decision to open direct negotiations with Russia on ending the war, dismaying Ukraine and its European supporters by excluding them from the preliminary talks last week.

In the UN General Assembly, the US joined Russia in voting against a Europe-backed Ukrainian resolution that calls out Moscow's aggression and demands an imme-



diate withdrawal of Russian troops. The US then abstained from voting on its own competing resolution after Europeans, led by France, succeeded in amending it to make clear Russia was the aggressor. The voting was taking place on the third anniversary of Russia's invasion and as Trump was hosting French President Emmanuel Macron in Washington.

It was a major setback for the Trump administration in the 193-member world body, whose resolutions are not legally binding but are seen as a barometer of world opinion. The US then pushed for a vote on its original draft in the more powerful UN Security Council, where resolutions are legally binding and it has veto power along with Russia, China and France.



Mizoram Gov. calls for swift NH-306 repairs

Aizawl, Feb 24: Mizoram Governor General (Retired) Vijay Kumar Singh has urged a Centrally-owned construction company to expedite the widening work of NH-306, the state's primary lifeline linking Assam, official sources said

Singh embarked on his maiden tour to other districts of the state and on Saturday visited Kolasib district, which shares a border with Assam.

During a meeting with officials, local leaders and representatives of organisations in Kolasib, Singh expressed concern about repairing work of the national highway being at a snail's pace in Kolasib district, which according to him, has greatly affected the public, the sources

Citing that many issues relating to compensation and forest clearance for the widening of the national highway have been settled, the Governor urged the National Highways and Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd. (NHIDCL), which is entrusted with the widening task.

Assam's economy projected to reach | Explosive cache neutralized \$143 billion by 2030, says CM Sarma

Sarma said the Modi government encourages states to attract investments

Guwahati, Feb 25: Assam will have a USD 143 billion economy by 2030, Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma claimed on Tuesday. urging investors to join the state's growth trajectory.

Speaking at the inaugural function of the two-day 'Advantage Assam 2.0 Investment and Infrastructure Summit' here, Sarma emphasised that the state has emerged from being the "most disturbed" to the "most peaceful" now. "The state's GDP growth this year will be 15.2 per cent.

at Manipur-Myanmar border

Imphal, Feb 26: The mine bomb experts of the Indian paramilitary and state police jointly detected several explosive items planted by the armed miscreants along the Indo-Myanmar border in the Tengnoupal district of Manipur on Tuesday.

The explosive devices were destroyed in situ in a series of operations conducted as a part of the search and area domination operations in the fringe and vulnerable areas of hill and valley districts, the police said. A joint team from the Bomb Detection and

Disposal squad and the Assam Rifles and Manipur police, based on intelligence inputs from different sources rushed to H Mongjang village under the Moreh police station in the jurisdiction of Tengnoupal district with Myanmar on the south.

The team uncovered one pompi with 10 ft in length (84mm),. a Pompi (51mm improvised Mortar), and three Pompi bombs. These bombs were neutralized in situ averting a potential major disaster in the district. urther, the team also destructed three Improvised

Illegal checkpost and bunker dismantled in Kangpokpi

Imphal, Feb 24: Joint security forces comprising state police and central paramilitary personnel have dismantled an illegal checkpost and a bunker in the Kangpokpi district, Manipur.

Similarly, a bunker constructed by armed miscreants at L Champhai village under the Leimakhong police station was dismantled on Monday. These illegal structures had been operational since the onset of ethnic conflicts in May 2023, which have resulted



in over 250 deaths and displaced thousands of people. The removal of these checkposts is expected to ensure the free movement of vehicles and people in the region.

The joint operation is seen as a significant step towards restoring peace and normalcy in the region.

16th Finance Commission arrives in Aizawl for a 4-day official visit

■ Mizoram's development funding focus of FC visit

Aizawl, Feb 24: A delegation of the 16th Finance Commission led by its chairman Arvind Panagariya, arrived in Mizoram on Sunday for a four-day visit to assess the state's fiscal needs and development priorities, official sources

Soon after their arrival, the members paid a courtesy visit to state Governor Vijay Kumar Singh, who apprised the members of the needs of the state, the sources said.

Singh also urged the Finance Commission to have some understanding of the state because of its low revenue generation when it submits its recommendation and proposals to the Centre, it said, During the meeting, the Governor



pointed out several issues, including challenges in infrastructural development in the state due to the hilly terrain, the influx of refugees from neighbouring countries and the state and the challenges in handling them, the menace of drug trafficking and abuse, and empowerment of law and enforcement agencies, the sources said.

He also stressed the

need for the upgradation of the state's lone airport in Lengpui and the generation of employment for youths, the sources said.

During their four-day stay in Aizawl, the members will meet Chief Minister Lalduhoma, officials, political parties, representatives of three ADCs, local bodies and village councils, among others, officials

SDSA accuses Assam Rifles of aiding militants

Guwahati, Feb 24: The Senapati District Students' Association (SDSA) has accused Assam Rifles of facilitating militant movement in Manipur.

SDSA president, Saloni Tony, levelled the allegations against the Assam Rifles and accused the para-military force of facilitating the movement of militants in Naga-inhabited regions on February 22.

According to Tonv. SDSA officials personally witnessed Assam Rifles personnel escorting cadres of the United People's Front (UPF), a Kuki militant group operating under the Suspension of Operations (SOO) agreement. Tony said that this collusion has raised concerns about the paramilitary force's intentions, questioning whether they are attempting to dis-



rupt the peace and create distrust among the people of Senapati.

The SDSA has also expressed concerns over the Assam Rifles' Director General engaging in dialogue with top Kuki militant leaders, urging the paramilitary force to maintain neutrality and expedite the peace process without favouring any particular armed faction.

The FICCI Cascade report underscores the impact of the global illegal trade, which contributes to a shadow economy valued at \$2 trillion annually, over 3% of global GDP. Approximately 11.6% of cigarettes consumed worldwide are illicit, leading to \$40.5 billion in tax losses. In India, illicit tobacco trade cost the government ₹13,331 crore in 2022, with illegal cigarette volumes reaching 30.2 billion sticks, positioning India as one of the most affected nations after China and Brazil, according to Euromonitor International's 2023 report.

The World Health Organisation (WHO) Framework Convention on Tobacco Control identifies India as both a transit hub and a key market for illicit tobacco. Smuggling networks span across borders, making this a global concern that demands coordinated international efforts. While Indian enforcement agencies, including the Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) and Customs, have stepped up crackdowns, illicit trade remains a persistent issue. The top-flight North American league also fined Messi's teammate Luis Suarez on Tuesday for violating the same "face/head/neck of an opponent policy" during halftime, when he pinched the back of Norwegian defender Birk Risa's neck.

India beat Pakistan with VK's 51st ODI Century



Dubai, 23 Feb: Virat Kohli brought up his 51st ODI century as he guided India to a win over Pakistan in the Champions Trophy in Dubai on Sunday. This defeat puts Pakistan on the brink of elimination as they'll have to pray that Bangladesh defeat New Zealand on Monday and then they themselves have to defeat Bangladesh in their last group match with the net run rate likely to come in play.

Kohli who looked in inspired form got to his milestone in 111 deliveries in an innings studded with 7 fours. It was a typical photo finish to the contest as Kohli got to his century in the last ball of the match, slamming a boundary. He was ably supported in the middle by Shreyas Iyer who scored a half century in 63 deliveries after an uncharacteristic slow start before shifting gears.

Earlier, Kohli had become the fastest batter to reach 14,000 ODI runs during the match against Pakistan at the Dubai International Cricket Stadium. The 36-year-old Kohli surpassed Sachin Tendulkar (350 innings), by achieving the feat in only 287 innings. Kohli got to the landmark when he reached 15 runs in the chase against Pakistan. Kohli is only the third batter ever to reach the milestone after Tendulkar and Sri Lanka's Kumar Sangakkara who crossed the milestone in 378 innings in 2015.

he former India captain only took 10 innings to cross from 13,000 to 14,000.

Kohli, Rohit still have a lot of cricket left: Dhawan

Dubai, Feb 24: Virat Kohli and Rohit Sharma have "a lot of cricket left in them". former India opener and Champions Trophy winner Shikhar Dhawan says, adding that the mere presence of the veteran duo can unsettle any opposition.

Kohli hit an unbeaten 100 on Sunday, his 51st ODI century, as India swept aside Pakistan by six wickets in Dubai to stand on the cusp of the ICC Champions Trophy semi-finals. Pakistan, who are hosting all of the games except those involving India, are on the brink of elimination after their second defeat of the tournament. Rohit made a quickfire 20 at the top of the innings as India went after 242 for victory and Kohli took charge after the captain's exit to steer the team home with 45 balls to spare.

Kohli, 36, and Rohit, 37, have struggled for form since retiring from internationals after last year's World Cup win, with speculation swirling that they could soon retire. But Kohli rolled back the years with his first ODI century since November 2023.

"Virat standing on the crease, his presence is big. The opposition have fear in them," said Dhawan, who is in Dubai as a tournament ambassador. Kohli went past 14,000 ODI runs early in his innings, becoming only the third batsman to achieve the landmark after Sachin Tendulkar and Kumar Sangakkara.

IOA forms ad-hoc panel to oversee boxing affairs

Chennai, Feb 25: Indian boxing seems to be in soup at the moment. In a dramatic turn of events, the Indian Olympic Association formed a five-member ad-hoc committee on Monday to run the day-to-day affairs of the Boxing Federation of India (BFI). The IOA, in a letter to all the stakeholders, alleged administrative issues surrounding BFI and said that the boxing federation's inability to hold elections on time compelled them to take this extreme step.

Responding to this development, the BFI said this move is against the constitution of the IOA itself and PT Usha, as the president of the organisation, cannot form an ad-hoc committee without the approval of the

executive committee. Additionally, they are set to challenge the decision in court. As things stand, the IOA is divided between two warring factions — Usha on one side and some eight to ten executive members on the other. Whether or not IOA's ad-hoc committee can continue also depends on other factors like the sports ministry and its recognition. As of now, the sports ministry has not reacted to this. Interestingly, the sports ministry has not spoken about de-affiliation which means the funding and other support will not stop. Going by the IOA letter, Madukant Pathak has been named the chairman of the aforementioned committee

Modric stunner keeps Real Madrid in title race

Modric's goal and Vinicius' strike secure vital win for Real Madrid

Barcelona, Feb 24: Luka Modric scored a brilliant goal from long range to help Real Madrid secure a 2-0 win against Girona on Sunday which took them back level with Barcelona at the top of La Liga.

Vinicius Junior wrapped up the win late on as Carlo Ancelotti's side produced a solid display at the Santiago Bernabeu.

After rivals Barcelona and Atletico Madrid, now third, both won on Saturday, the pressure was on for the champions in the extremely tight title race. Madrid had not won in their



prior three league games but flexed their muscles by thrashing Man City in the Champions League in midweek. "It's a very important win, we have to stay in the fight," Modric told Real Ma-

drid TV. "We can't let our level slip and consider ourselves satisfied, we can still grow as a team." The Croatian's goal was the highlight of the match.

"I was by myself, I con-

trolled the ball. I hit it well and it went in," Modric added. "I don't know if it's one of the most spectacular I've scored, it was really nice, it's always special to score at the Bernabeu." Madrid were without suspended England international Jude Bellingham after his red card last weekend.

Last year's surprise title contenders Girona were hard for Madrid to break down but far less threatening in attack than at their fluent best. Gazzaniga saves from Mbappe; Vinicius misses chance with French partner.
